These units are certified with IP54 and IK10 standards, ensuring resistance to dust, water, and impact, providing users with a secure and durable charging experience.

Key features include adjustable power settings, smartphone connectivity, and the ability to schedule charging sessions through the EV ONE mobile app, allowing users to easily start and monitor their charging process. With a simple QR code scan, the charging experience is both seamless and efficient, while an emergency stop button and integrated safety protections, such as lightning protection and leak detection. Additionally, it is equipped with an advanced fire suppression system and comprehensive fire safety solutions to ensure optimal operational safety.
